

Ceremony on the Riffelberg in the “Bruder Klaus” chapel

The Riffelberg chapel “Bruder Klaus” stands on a hill in the shadow of the Matterhorn, at a height of 2,590 metres. From here, you will have an unforgettable panoramic view of the Matterhorn above and the valley below.

The chapel was consecrated in August 1961 by Arthur Elchinger, bishop of Strasbourg, and is owned by the burghers of Zermatt. It is dedicated to Nicholas of Flüe, the patron saint of Switzerland. Architect Ferdinand Pfammatter developed the plans. The outline of the building is almost the same as that of the Weisshorn, the pyramid-like four-thousander on the other side of the valley.

Additional information for organising your wedding

The mountain chapel seats 50 guests and has space for the bride and groom and 6 witnesses. The chapel may only be used for free for wedding ceremonies by wedding parties who have booked a drinks reception and meal in the Riffelhaus.*

* Use of the chapel costs CHF 1,500.00. The cost is reduced to CHF 500.00 when a drinks reception package is booked. If you book a drinks reception package and a wedding package, the chapel can be used free of charge. The priest is not included in the price.

Price per person: CHF 170.– (minimum 10 persons)

For those who want to follow up an excellent meal by partying into the early hours, we recommend our open-bar service, which costs CHF 45.– per person, per hour. This price includes gin, vodka, cognac, Ramazzotti, rum, amaretto, tequila, apricot brandy, pear brandy, cherry brandy, grappa, mineral water and soft drinks.

Weddings in the Riffelhaus 1853: 25 newly renovated hotel rooms await you on the Riffelberg. The ceremony will be held in the mountain chapel next to the hotel. Wedding guests can enjoy the view of the majestic Matterhorn at the drinks reception on the sun terrace before heading to the restaurant for the wedding dinner. All the bride and groom need to do is say “I do”.

Travel to car-free Zermatt: Take the Matterhorn Gotthard Bahn from Täsch (service every 20 minutes, approx. 10 minutes travelling time); change in Zermatt to the Gornergrat railway (1-minute walk from Zermatt railway station) and continue to the end of the line at Riffelberg (approx. 30 minutes travelling time).
